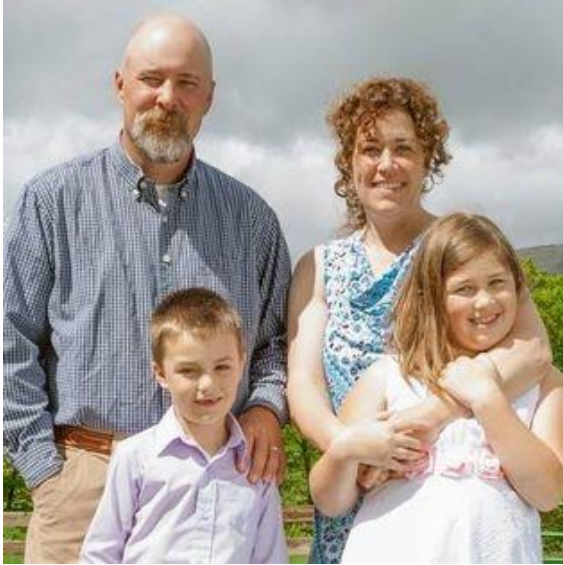

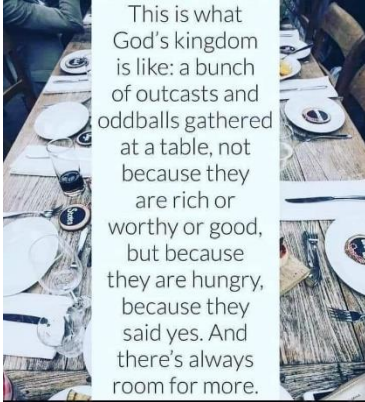
The **Wired** WORD
