#### ANNUAL ICE CREAM SOCIAL

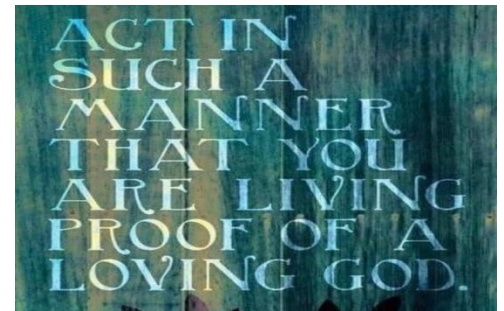


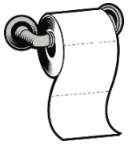
