

Before Christmas we celebrate Advent - a time of expectation and preparation for the birth of the Lord. The word "Advent" derives from the Latin word "adventus," which means "coming," and is associated with the four weeks of preparation for Christmas.

Hope is a predominant theme of Advent. The Israelites hoped for a Messiah to come, and Christ entered the world. We are hopeful for the arrival of Christ again into the world.

Advent also focuses on light as opposed to darkness.

We light candles each week during Advent to represent the concepts of hope, peace, joy, and love but also to remind us that Christ enters our dark world and casts away the darkness of sin to redeem us. He will come again as the light of the world.

The liturgical colors of Advent are purple, deep blue, and pink. Purple, the traditional color for Advent, represents penitence and the sovereignty of Christ. Deep blue symbolizes Christ as the "Dayspring" and the church's wait for Jesus' birth. And, lit on the third Sunday of Advent, the pink candle represents joy and marks the shift from penitence to anticipation.
